Court Rules of the TLA Pickleball Club

Only Thunder Lake Pickleball Club members in good standing and their guests are allowed to use the courts. Any other use must be authorized by the TLA Pickleball Club Committee. Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult member.

Thunder Lake Sportsman Club Shooting Events take priority over Pickleball Court Usage.

The courts are only to be used for their intended purpose. Tennis, skateboarding, rollerblading, basketball or other activities are not allowed.

Appropriate attire must be worn at all times when playing on the courts. Rubber-soled footwear is required. Flip flops, hiking shoes, street shoes, golf shoes, hard-heeled or black-soled shoes are not allowed.

Glass bottles are not permitted on the courts or in the seating area within the court fencing.

Vaping and/or smoking is not permitted on the courts or in the seating area within the court fencing. If you smoke anywhere around the courts, please properly dispose of your cigarette butts.

Dogs are not permitted on the courts or in the seating area within the court fencing.

During the hours of non-scheduled play and when others are waiting to play, playing time is limited to two hours for doubles matches and one hour for singles, counting the time from the start of play. Switching to another court for extended play is not allowed.

The court rules above were established by the TLA Pickleball Club Committee. Except as otherwise set forth in these specific rules and policies, the rules and code of conduct of the International Federation of Pickleball (IFP) shall apply.
